- On July 30, Dr. Ramachandran and Mr. Gautham, supporters of Vidya Vanam, visited the school.

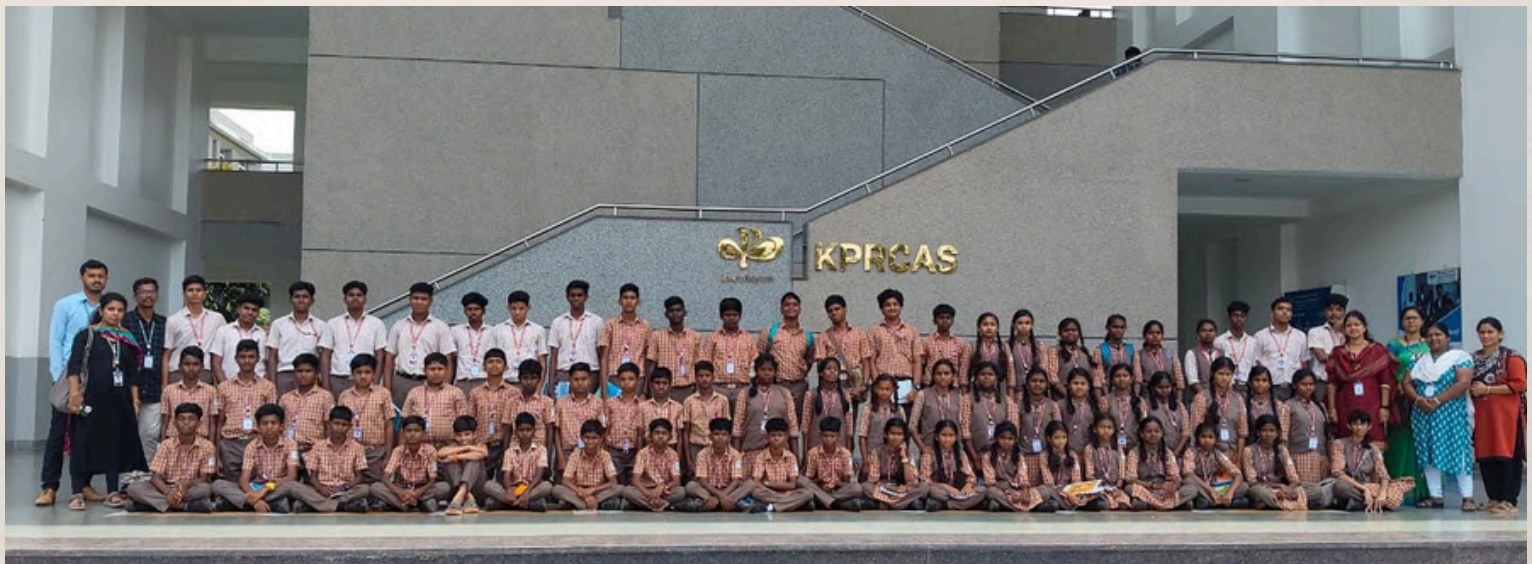


# AUGUST
